Please don't get me wrong. Not all movies and shows are all bad. Not all video games are wrong, but when it becomes something that you cannot give up, it has become your god and your Lord. If something other than God reigns supreme, there is another god that you worship. And God simply cannot move on your life. God Himself is not given room to whisper to you, to reveal Himself and show you who He is. It took a media fast as family for an extended period of time to even realize the magnitude of how de-sensitized we had become and how like the world we were and our views were. The best part was how clear the voice of God was becoming and how fast He moved in our lives with our full attention and heart toward Him; we know first hand what God can do with a heart yielded to Him!
